

## Friendship Group Discussion Questions 4/23/2017

Sermon: "Lambs and Wolves" – Luke 9:53-10:3

1. What is the most remote place you've ever traveled? Have you ever traveled to a place where you didn't feel safe?
2. Read the scripture listed above.
3. Discuss Jesus' tone in this passage, specifically how He talks to the grieving son and the man who wants to say goodbye to his loved ones. If God is all-loving, how does this compute?
4. In reading this passage, what seems to be of the utmost importance to Jesus? (Leader hint: the harvest!) What is the harvest? Have you ever participated in a short or long term mission trip? Share what your labor entailed.
5. Discuss how you may feel like a lamb amidst wolves in your neighborhood, school, or work context in laboring for the harvest.
6. Out yourself time! Do you feel a pull or call to go out to a different culture or country on a short-term or long-term basis? Remember that Michael's friend felt a pull that took seven years to come to fruition.

Prayer focus: Pray for more labors to go out into the harvest. Pray about your role in the harvest, both locally and globally. Pray for our church to be a church of the harvest.
